# Foundation Project

The Foundation Project was developed in partnership with The new Housing Association. The project provides a housing support service to adults with a learning disability. It is based in an attractive purpose built block of flats in the Calton area of Glasgow.

The block includes seven flats which provide individual tenancies for nine service users and one on-site staff flat.

The staff team provides a 24 hour flexible service which meets the preferred lifestyle and choices of individual service users enabling them to live as independently as possible within the community.

# Referral Criteria

Foundation Project provides services for adults of 18 years upwards who have a learning disability and associated physical and/or sensory disabilities. Referrals are made by local authority Care Managers or health professionals. A single shared assessment will be carried out with the service users needs and desires at the centre of all discussions.

# Services Offered

A flexible service which meets the service users developing needs

A named key worker

A person-centred and regularly reviewed care support plan developed with the service user which recognises their individual rights, needs and choices

Trained staff who will support the service user in a professional, valuing and flexible manner

Support to enable the service user to live as independent a life as possible and to feel safe and secure within their home and community

Support to enable the service user to expand their capabilities and achievements by accessing a range of community services, resources and activities; to live a life rich in purpose and personal fulfilment and to achieve all they can

Support in assisting the service user to maintain their tenancies e.g. managing their budget, housework, cooking and life skills

Support to the service user to develop and maintain social networks, recreational, educational and / or occupational interests

Support to access appropriate health care, counselling and advice

The project is registered with and inspected by the Care Commission. Reports are available on request.
