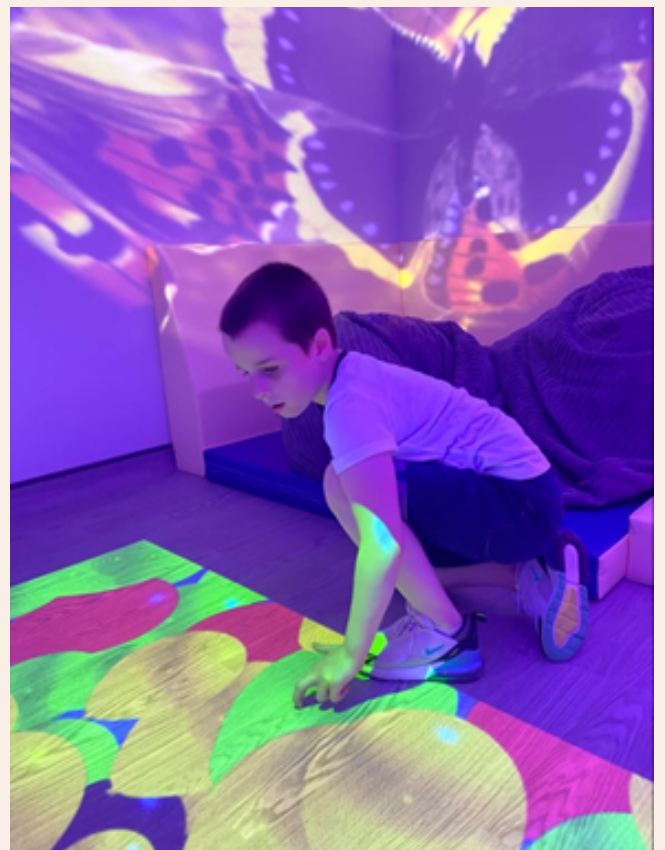

Roslin House is a state-of-the-art respite service where children with additional support needs come to have fun.

The 8 bedded service, commissioned by North Ayrshire Health and Social Care Partnership, is part of an extensive new development situated within Lockhart Campus in Stevenston. It replaces our beloved Muirfield Place service. A larger premises means we're able to support more families at the same time, but we're still keeping the ethos and approach that made Muirfield Place such a success story.

What We Offer

For the young people who come here we want it to feel like a holiday, so we put a lot of thought and energy into making it as fun as possible for them. We encourage a culture of self-acceptance and create a space for young people to play together, make new friends and enjoy new experiences.



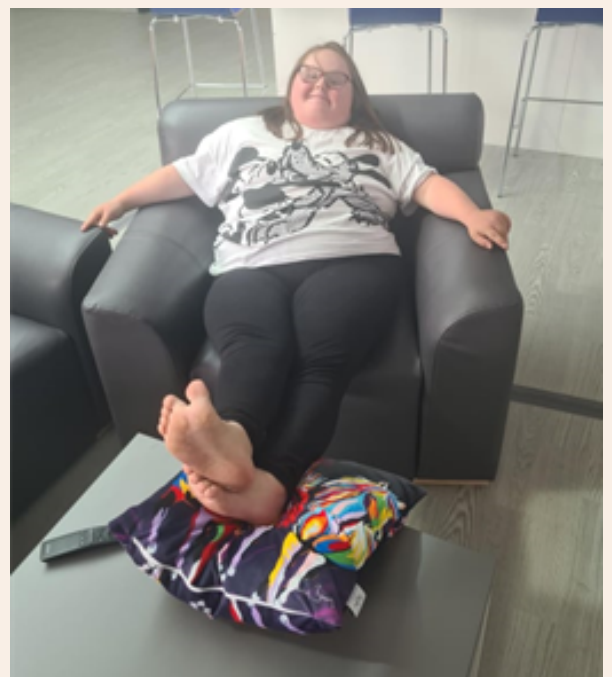
The house is spacious and provides wheelchair access throughout. Each ensuite bedroom is equipped with comfortable, homely furnishings, flat screen tv and mood lighting, with rooms opening out onto a fantastic landscaped garden.

Each bedroom has a unique theme including Disney, Jungle, Unicorn and Dino Den.



We also have an activity wing with an area for arts and crafts, a hi-tech sensory room, quiet room, a games room with sofas and TV, and a kitchen area where young people can eat together or learn cooking skills.

During their stay the children and young people continue to attend their daytime placements. E.g. if they attend school, they will arrive after school on the first day of their time with us, and return home after school on the last day of their stay.

How We Support You

We help our young people to stay active, going on adventures, visiting trampoline parks and swimming. We're here to help you achieve your goals and overcome obstacles too, like work placements or college courses. Best of all, Roslin House is a great place to have fun and make friends!



Family Involvement

Roslin House is more than just a service, it's a forward-thinking community, where parents and young people can all benefit from peer to peer support. We have an accessible mini-bus which we use for group outings to places like Deep Sea World or Blair Drummond Safari Park – the whole family can come along!



Circle of Support

We also run regular open days where families from the local area can come together, explore the play bus, enjoy a magic show and dance their socks off in the disco. Alongside outings and open days we run our Circle of Support sessions, where parents and carers come together for a cup of tea, some food and a chat in a relaxed, supportive environment. We often bring special guests and provide complimentary therapies too, so you might even end up getting a massage!
